SUBJECT: Consideration of a Resolution Authorizing the Village Administrator to Execute a Contract with 10-S Court Solutions to Resurface the Centennial Park Tennis Courts in the Amount of \$18,900.00

SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:

The tennis courts in Centennial Park have become a safety hazard for all of those who use them for either tennis or pickle ball. In January, 2017 a request for proposals (RFP) was published to address this issue, and allow a contractor to come in and strip the courts and resurface them back to safe play conditions for all players. The original RFP was returned with 3 proposals which included 2 companies with the exact same proposal, which also happen to be the low bid. We asked both companies if they would be interested in submitting another bid as neither of them has any other factors that would cause a greater concern than the other.

Both proposals were resubmitted with new numbers and additional items included which provided us with the differentiation that was needed to move forward with the selection process. As a matter of financial difference 10-S Solutions of Lake Forest offered a proposal of \$18,900 and also included 2 competition tennis nets for each court at a value of approximately \$190 each.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH 10-S COURT SOLUTIONS TO RESURFACE THE CENTENNIAL PARK TENNIS COURTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$18,900.00

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the tennis courts in Centennial Park have become a safety hazard for all of those who use them for either tennis or pickle ball; and

WHEREAS, in January, 2017 a Request for Proposals (RFP) was published to seek a contractor to strip and resurface the courts back to safe play conditions for all players; and

WHEREAS, the original RFP was returned with 3 proposals, which included 2 proposals matching each other as the lowest cost option; and

WHEREAS, after a resubmittal by both companies, 10-S Solutions of Lake Forest offered a proposal of \$18,900 and also included 2 competition tennis nets for each court at a value of approximately \$190 each;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Village Board that the Village Administrator is authorized to Execute a Contract with 10-S Court Solutions to Resurface the Centennial Park Tennis Courts in the Amount of \$18,900.00
