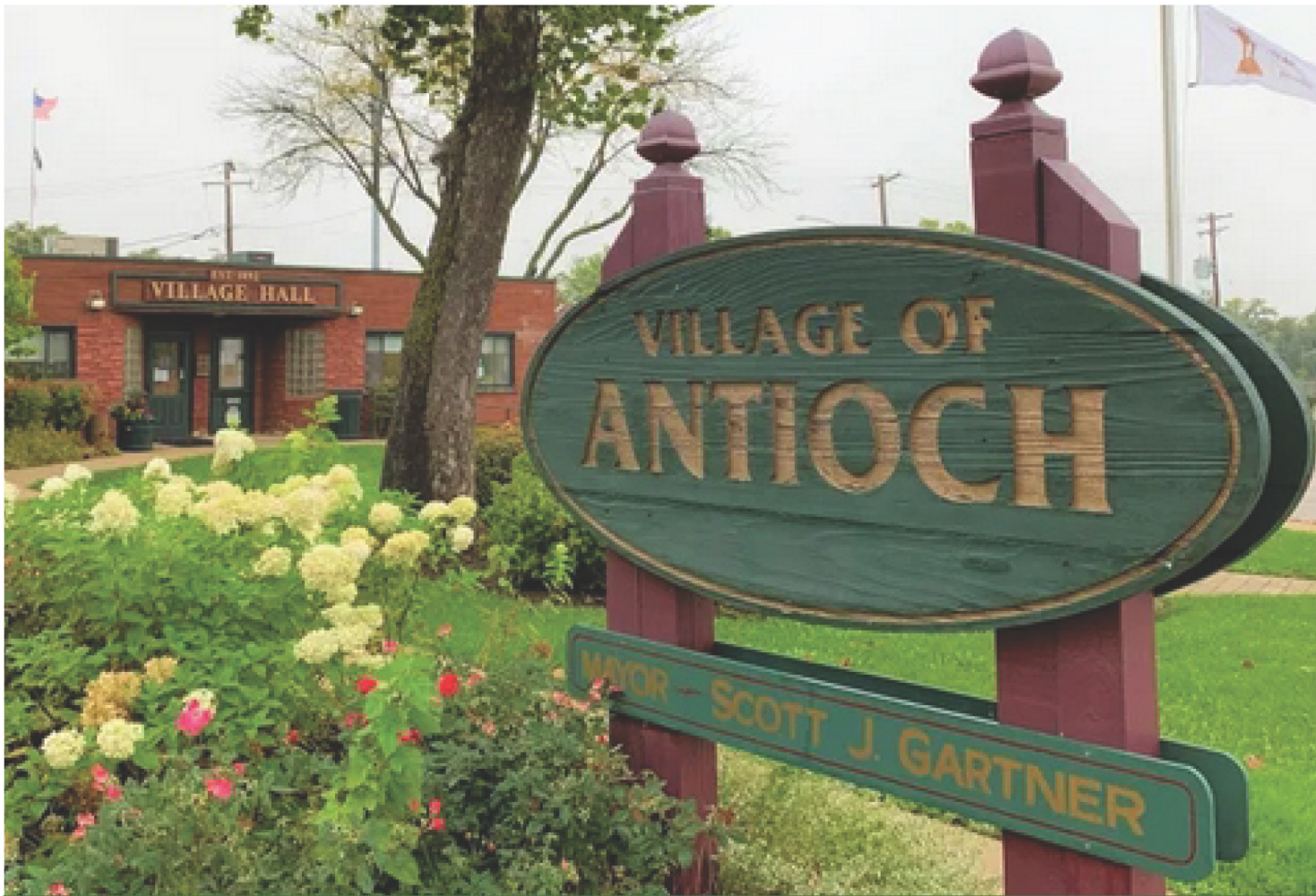

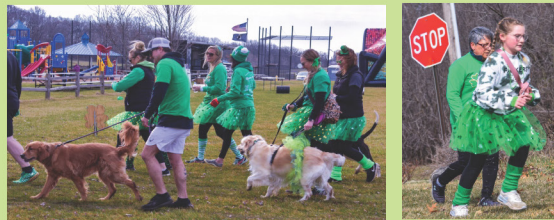

Payments are made on a monthly basis and due beginning August 1st. If payments are not received by the 7th of each month a \$25 late fee will be added.

Recognizing that play is a very important aspect of a child's development, the Camp Crayon Preschool is based on the concept of learning through play and simple structured activities.

Our program is a social program for 2, 3, 4, and 5 year olds. It is often a child's first experience away from the home environment. The children in our program will be provided with the opportunity to develop emotional, social, physical and intellectual skills through a variety of creative and fun learning activities.

Classes will begin in September and will run through mid May. To be considered for registration, children must be the correct age by September 1, 2024. There is a maximum of 20 children per class.

The teacher to student ratio is 1:7.

TIME FOR ME TWO

This fun class provides young children with the opportunity to experience a “preschool” environment before they go to preschool. This is a unique experience between a parent and child. In this class children will participate in many developmentally appropriate activities such as crafts, music, movement, art and playtime. This is a great opportunity for social interactions with peers. Toilet training is not required.

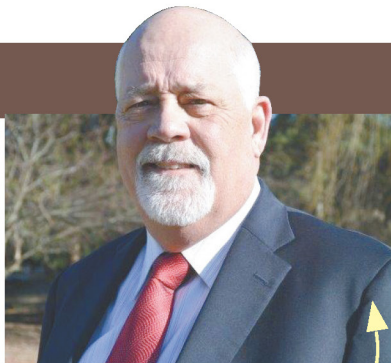

ANTIOCH WAVES SWIM TEAM

- The Antioch Waves Swim Team is a fun, professionally coached recreational program, dedicated to developing each child's swimming skills, in a moderately competitive environment. Children between the ages of 5-18 years of age as of June 1st are eligible to join our team. There are no tryouts; the only requirement to join is the ability to swim one length of the 25 yard pool unassisted.
